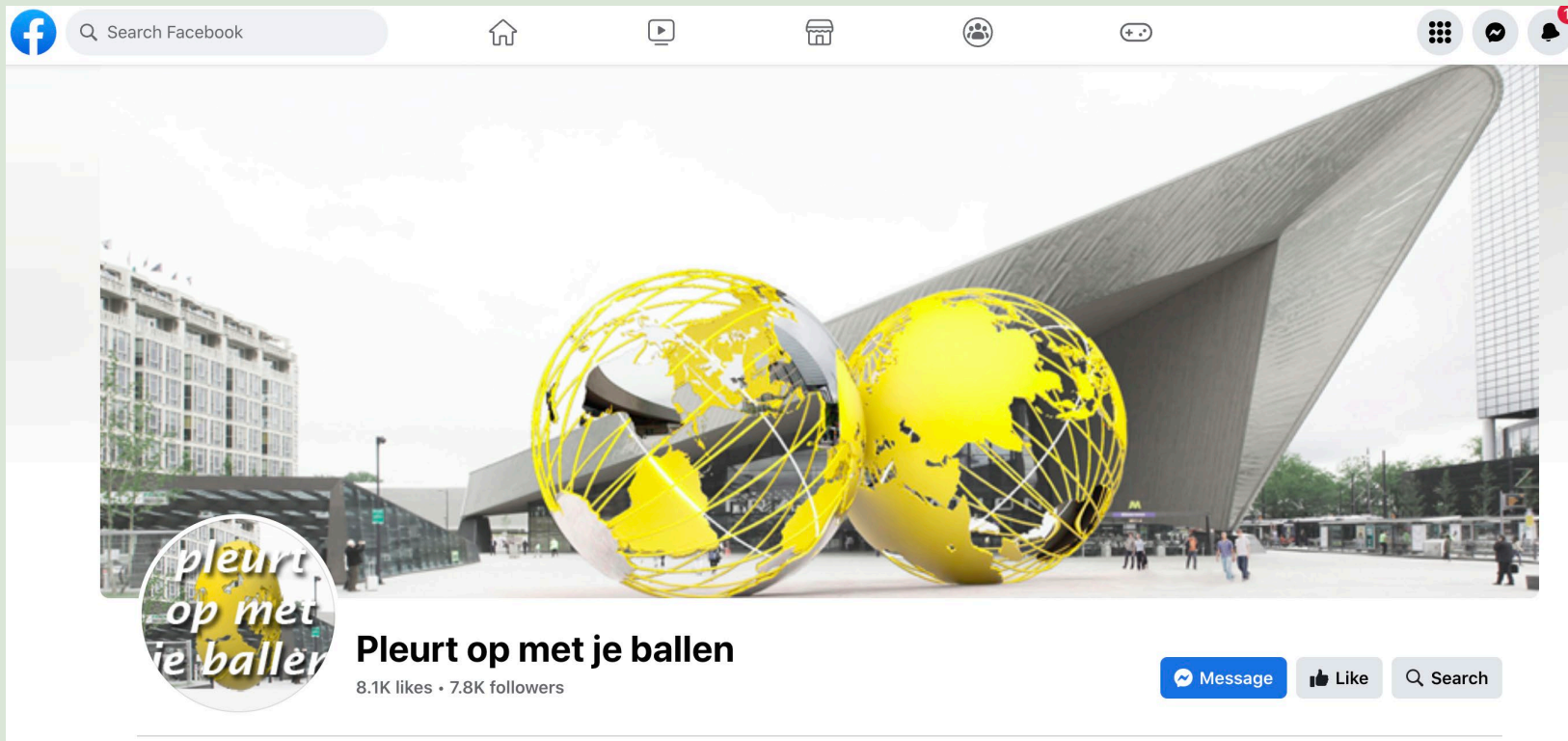

“Big brother.”



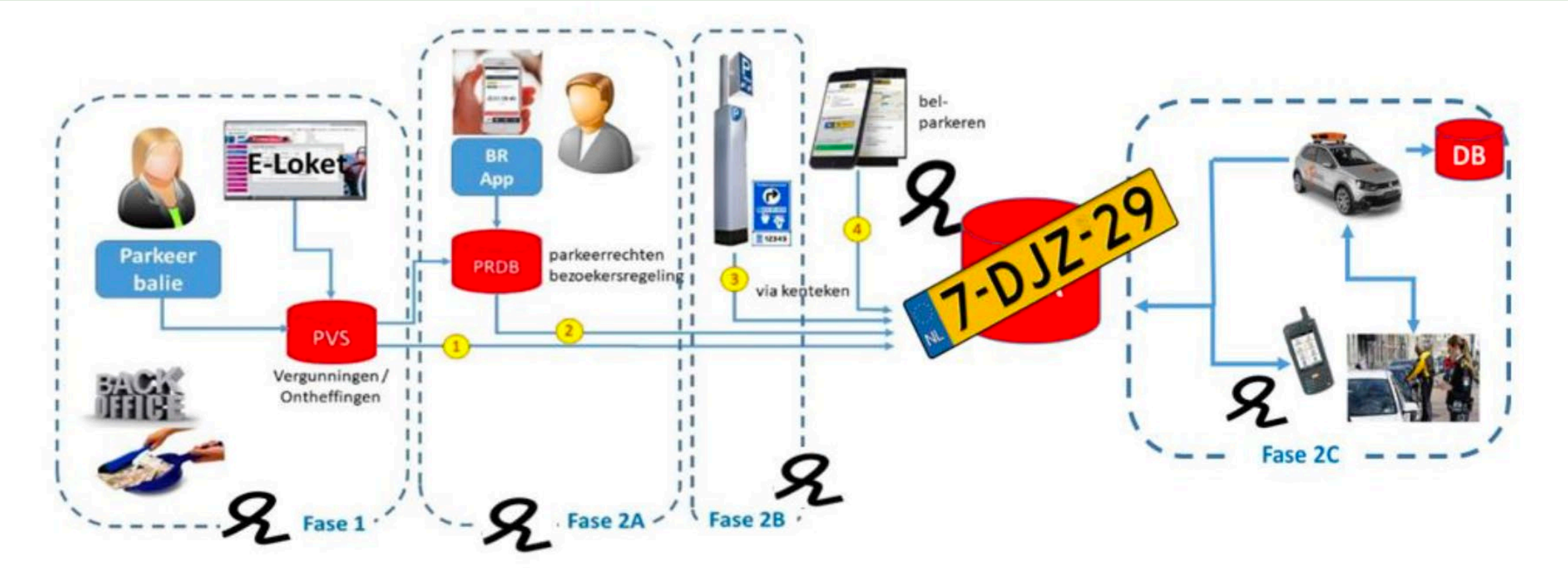

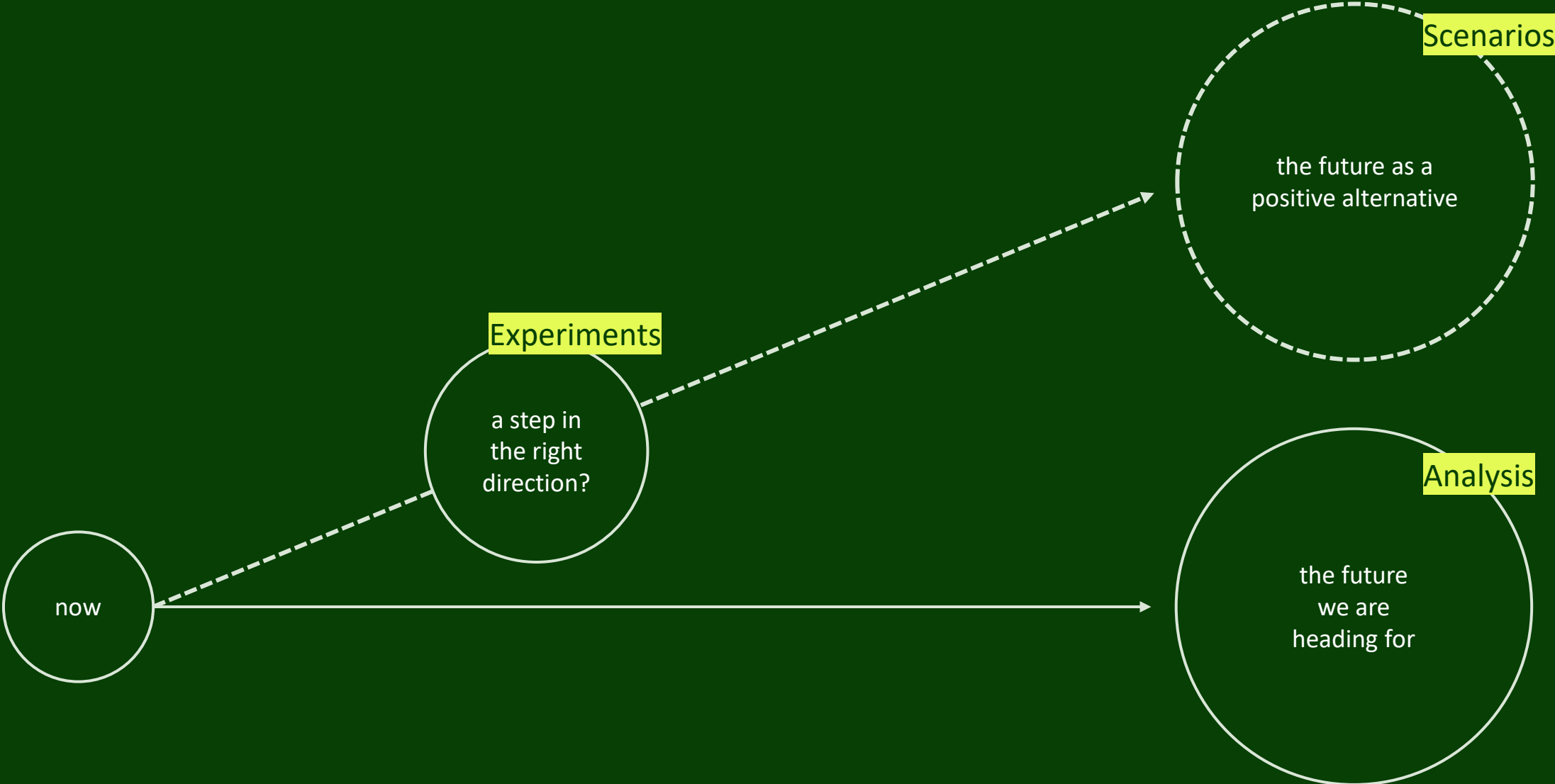
# There is no perspective on changing things collectively

not quite an architectural model



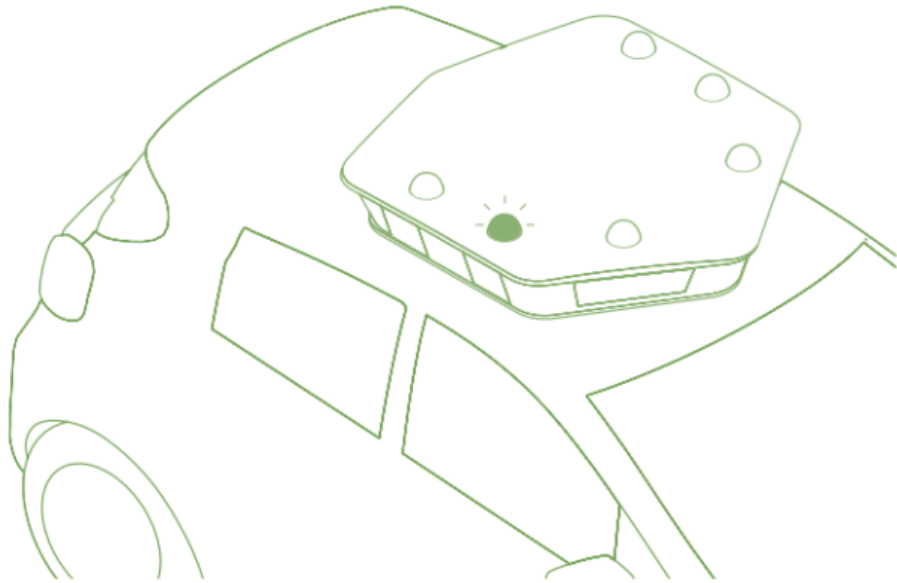
